2 26-11-2024 The present writ petition has been filed for directing the Circle Officer, Jogapatti Anchal, District-West Champaran, i.e. the respondent no.3 to remove the encroachment made by the private respondents over the public road (*Aam Rasta*), situated at Thana No.5, Village-Gora, Katahari Tola, P.S.-Jogapatti, District- West Champaran, appertaining to Khata No.4, Khesara No.325/33/1.
