APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has renewed his prayer for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 414, 120(B) of the Indian Penal code and Section 25(I-AA), 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act, which was earlier rejected by this Court vide order dated 10.04.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 39842 of 2022 with a direction to learned trial court to conclude the trial within a period of four months failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.

4. In compliance of order dated 15.12.2023, a progress report dated 5.1.2024 has been received from which it appears that trial is likely to be concluded within a period of



four months.

5. Trial is likely to be concluded very soon. In that view of the matter, this application stands disposed off.

7. The learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of four months positively, failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer for bail.
