2.              The present petition has been filed for restoration of a criminal writ petition bearing Cr.W.J.C. no. 394 of 2021, which has stood dismissed on account of non compliance of the peremptory order dated 06.07.2023.
3.              Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that all the defects have been removed, pursuant to the peremptory order dated 06.07.2023, except defect no. 5, hence, a sympathetic view may be taken and the aforesaid writ



application be restored to its original file.
