2 30-10-2024 In this case, on 23.10.2024, relief was granted to the petitioner. Further, now a modification petition has been filed submitting that in the bail petition itself, in paragraph no.8, inadvertently, the court was recorded as learned Special Exclusive Excise Judge, Danapur which should have been the court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was fault on his part for which he would like to pay Rs.500/- to Patna High Court Legal Services Committee.

3. The paragraph no.8 of the order dated 23.10.2024 in Cr. Misc. No. 55298 stands modified to the following extent:-

*8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on
furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten*



thousand) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Amnour P.S. Case No. 132 of 2024 subject to the conditions as mentioned in order dated 23.10.2024:

4. Accordingly, Cr. Misc. No. 79104 of 2024 is allowed and the order dated 23.10.2024 stands modified to the extent as mentioned above subject to the payment of Rs.500/- to the Patna High Court Legal Services Committee.
