ORAL ORDER

3 29-02-2024 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the parties.

2 The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Amas PS Case No 246 of 2023 dated 12.07.2023 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 8 (C), 20, 29/35 of the NDPS Act.

3 From perusal of the First Information Report, it is apparent that total 800 Gms of Ganja was recovered in front of Vishnu Vihar Hotel, GT Road, South Lane situated in Village – Navgarh.

4 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner has submitted that the name of petitioner has surfaced from the statement of local Chowkidar. Petitioner was not



arrested on the spot. No independent witness has identified the seizure memo.

5 Learned APP appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.

6 Considering the facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the petitioner, let the petitioner above named be released on bail on his furnishing bonds of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sessions Judge -cum- Special Judge, NDPS Act, Gaya in Special (NDPS) being Amas PS Case No 246 of 2023.
