ORAL ORDER

2 11-12-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the informant and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 126(2), 115(2), 118(2), 109(1), 329(3), 329(4), 303(2), 351(3), 352, 3(5) of B.N.S.

3. Allegedly, the petitioners along with other accused persons have assaulted the informant and his family members by means of knife.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. It is



further submitted that there is case and counter case between the parties. As per injury report which is annexed as annexure-2 of the bail application, it is clear that injury was found to be simple in nature. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para 3 of the bail application.

5. Learned APP for the State and learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, and the nature of injury, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Daraunda P.S. Case No.346 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS, 2023.
