2 18-11-2024 Heard the learned counsels for the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that it is true that the nomination process has not started up-till now, but he has a reasonable apprehension that his nomination paper shall be rejected on the ground of non-availability of 'No Dues Certificate'. He has submitted further that a coordinate Bench of this Court in the case of *Pramila Sinha vs. The State of Bihar and Ors*, reported in *2014(4) PLJR 487* have been pleased to hold that it is not a disqualification for filing



nomination paper.

3. It is expected that at the time of considering the nomination paper of the petitioner, the principles decided by a co-ordinate bench of this court in the case of *Pramila Sinha vs. The State of Bihar and Ors*, reported in *2014(4) PLJR 487*, shall be taken into account.
