2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 308, 379, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegedly, the petitioner along with other co-accused persons armed with various weapons brutally assaulted the informant and also abused him due to which she sustained injuries.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and have committed no offence. He has been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. There is a case and counter-case between the parties. He further submits that the injuries are of simple nature. Petitioner has no criminal



antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as well as considering the nature of injury, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his/her arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Khizersarai P.S. Case No.197 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
