5 08-08-2024 This Court *vide* order dated 10.05.2024, had directed the authorities to make the necessary payments to the petitioner by the end of 01.07.2024. I.A. No. 01 of 2024 is filed by the Respondent-BIADA seeking 12 weeks further time for making the payments.

nearly after three months, this Court is not inclined to grant the time sought for by the Respondent-BIADA in I.A. No. 01 of 2024 but however, as a matter of indulgence further time of two months from today is granted to the Respondent-BIADA to make the necessary payments. In case payment is not made by the end of two months, the petitioner would be entitled to the interest at the rate of 9% from the date of actual approval to the date of payment.

3. With the above direction, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
