Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable u/s 363, 366A, 34 of the IPC.

3. Allegedly, the petitioner and other co-accused persons
are said to have taken away the daughter of the informant for the
purpose of marriage.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. He
has been falsely implicated in this case due to grudge. No such
occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The
allegation leveled against the petitioner is not specific rather
general and omnibus in nature. The statement of the victim has
been recorded u/s 164 Cr.P.C., in which, she has not supported



the prosecution case. She stated that she solemnized marriage with the petitioner on her own sweet will. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since the victim has not supported the prosecution case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Piprahi P.S. Case No.86/2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
