Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable u/s 120(B), 147, 148, 149, 379, 427,
337, 420, 467, 468, 471 of the IPC.

3. Allegedly, in order to dispossess the land of the
informant, the petitioner and other co-accused persons fired
upon him and his family members and also took away cow, goat
and other agricultural items.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that
petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence.
They have been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior



motive. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners and similarly situated co-accused namely Nepal Rai has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide order dated 18.12.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No.80224 of 2023. No person sustained any injury in the present case. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, since similarly situated co-accused has been granted bail, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Sahebpur Kamal P.S. Case No.320 of 2022, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
