ORAL ORDER

4 10-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Birupur P.S. Case No. 17 of 2023 dated 31.03.2023 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 302, 307, 326 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons are alleged to have surrounded the informant and his family members and started firing on them indiscriminately. In the meantime, the petitioner and co-accused Amit and Manish started firing due to that one Shravan Kumar died on the spot whereas the informant, his cousin brother



Anshu and Anand Mohan sustained firearm injuries.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. There is no specific allegation of over act against the petitioner rather the allegation is general and omnibus in nature. The petitioner has three criminal cases and he is on bail in all cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. Similarly situated co-accused person has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 17.08.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 51037 of 2023. The petitioner is in custody since 13.04.2023.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Lakhisarai in connection with Birupur P.S. Case No. 17 of 2023, with the following condition:-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically



present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
