2 04-12-2024 Though the present writ petition has been filed for directing the Respondent authorities to maintain peace over the land, appertaining to Khata No. 3, Khesra No. 49, area 32 decimal, Khesra No. 59, area 11 decimal, Khesra No. 82, area 1 acre 2 decimal, Khesra No. 90, area 30 decimal, Khesra No. 105, area 54 decimal, Khesra No. 209, area 76 decimal and Khesra No. 223, area 36 decimal, situated at Mauza-Malbigha, P.S.-Chandi, P.S. No. 222, Tauzi No. 2178, however, at the outset, the learned counsel for he petitioner seeks liberty on



behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law including that of filing a civil suit before the learned Civil Court having competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
