For issuance of an appropriate writ, in the nature of Mandamus, or any other appropriate writ/ writs, order/orders, direction/directions, command/commands for directing the respondents to construct the Public Road at Gram Panchayat Raj Birpur, East (Saat Ghar), Ward No. 01, from Kali Asthan to Panchpauniya Tola, since the population of that habitation is about 2000 and the

The said habitation is not connected by any connecting
road."*
