Mr.Dr.Mrityunjaya Kr.Gautam, learned APP for the State.

2. The instant application for anticipatory bail has been filed by the petitioner apprehending his arrest in connection with Nagar P.S. Case No. 364/2024, registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 307, 379, 504, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The case of the prosecution is that the informant asked the petitioner as to why he destroy the vapour light. On this the petitioner along with one other assaulted the informant. There is specific allegation against this petitioner that he has assaulted with iron rod on the head of the informant whereas Aakash Kumar Singh assaulted with



lathi.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence and he has falsely been implicated in this case. During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that from the perusal of the order of the trial Court, it is clear that the informant has received only one injury on his head and the nature of injury is simple caused by sharp object. The allegation is that of assaulting with iron rod, the injury which has been received does not co-relate with the allegation and the nature of injury is also simple. There is no repetition of blow. Petitioner is having no criminal antecedent.

5. In contra, learned APP appearing for the State has opposed the prayer of bail of the petitioner.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and in the facts and circumstances of the case as stated above, this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The petitioner is directed to surrender in the Court below within a period of four weeks from today and in the event of his arrest or surrender in connection with Nagar



P.S. Case No. 364/2024, he will be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Katihar, subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
