being preferred on behalf of the
above-named petitioner for setting
aside the order dated 22.06.2023
passed by Divisional Commissioner
Magadh Division, Gaya, in ICDS
Revision Case No. 122 of 2022
whereby and whereunder the revision*



filed by the petitioner has been dismissed and the order dated 01.07.2022 passed in Appeal No. 01 (Misc.) Selection 2022 by the District Programme Officer, Nawada and the order dated 22.12.2021 passed in Appeal No. 01 (Misc.) Selection 2021 by the Child Development Project Officer, Nawada Sadar, Nawada. And/ or for any other reliefs to which the petitioner found to be entitled in the course of hearing of this writ application."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a suit before the Ld. Civil Court having competent jurisdiction, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
