2. The present petition has been preferred for:

*issuance of an appropriate writ/writs
directing the respondents to decide the claim of the
petitioner for fixation of rent with respect to the
land in question which is pending at the stage of
D.C.L.R., Bikramganj vide Rent Fixation Case No.
1 of 2016-17. and/or to grant any other reliefs
which the petitioner is legally entitled in the facts
