2. The instance application for regular bail has been
filed by the petitioner in connection with Sessions Trial No. 409
of 2023 arising out of Bheldi of P.S. Case No. 194 of 2021
instituted for the offence u/s 341, 323, 447, 307, 504, 506,
302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Earlier the application for regular bail of the
petitioner was rejected by this court vide order dated 18.1.2023
passed in Cr. Misc. No. 22606 of 2022 with an observation to
expedite the trial.

4. In pursuance to the direction of this Court, a report
dt. 8.2.2024 with regard to the present stage of trial has been



received by which it appears that the trial is likely to be concluded within a period of nine months.

5. No fresh ground is made for reconsideration of the regular bail application of the petitioner, as such, his prayer is rejected.

6. Accordingly, this application stands disposed off.

7. Learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within a period of six (6) months, failing which the petitioner may renew his prayer of bail.
