learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has filed the instant application for grant of regular bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302/34, 364(A), 365 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case in nutshell is that informant's son namely, Md. Sahrul, on receiving call on mobile, went outside on his motorcycle but did not return. Even after intense search, he remain trace-less. On 1.2.2022, informant received a call through which a ransom of Rs. 50,00,000/- was demanded and



threatened him that if the demand would not be fulfilled, his son and informant would be murdered.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is innocent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. Neither the petitioner is named in F.I.R. nor there is any eye witness of the alleged occurrence. His name sprang up in this case on the confessional statement of co-accused Md. Guljar. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 02.02.2022. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioner has no criminal antecedent. Other co-accused, namely, Shekhar Singh and Bhibhishan Kumar Singh have been granted bail by this court and Co-ordinate Bench of this Court respectively.

5. Learned APP appearing for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for Bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and taking into consideration the facts and



circumstances of the case as well as period of custody,
this Court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail.
The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on
bail in connection with Azamnagar P.S. Case No. 26 of
2022 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees
ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each
to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Katihar.
