Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 302 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. Petitioners are said to have assaulted the informant and his family members.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that after due investigation, the I.O. has submitted final form against the petitioners but the learned court



below has taken cognizance against them. He submits that there is specific allegation against co-accused Ashok Mandal. He submits that there is no specific overt act against the petitioners. He further submits that petitioners have no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Ismailpur P.S. Case No. 82 of 2020, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
