2 12-12-2024 Heard learned counsels for the parties.

2. The petitioners apprehends their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 504, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the FIR, the petitioners and other co-accused persons assaulted the informant's side by means of rod and *danda* due to which they sustained injuries.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case. No such occurrence, in the manner as alleged, has ever taken place. The allegation levelled against the petitioners is not specific rather



general and omnibus in nature. It is submitted that for the alleged occurrence there is case and counter case between the parties. It is further submitted that the injuries are of the simple nature which is evident from supplementary injury report (Annexure-P/2). Petitioner nos. 1 and 3 have no criminal antecedent and petitioner no.2 has no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case as well as considering the nature of injury, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Traiya P.S. Case No.214 of 2024, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
