A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 504, 341, 323, 354(B), 427, 337, 379, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Allegation against the petitioner is that he along with other co-accused persons has abused and assaulted the informant side and also tried to outrage the modesty of daughter-in-law of the informant. It is further alleged that petitioner has assaulted son of the informant with bricks and one co-accused has also snatched gold chain from the daughter-in-law of the informant.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. No such occurrence as alleged ever took place. He has been



falsely implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. There is previous dispute between the parties. There is case and counter-case between the parties stated in para 10 of the bail application. No person has sustained injury in the alleged occurrence. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, considering the fact that there no persons has sustained injury, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Laheriasarai P.S. Case No. 466 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
