4 26-04-2024 The petitioner is concerned with the utilisation of cess funds, the educational cess collected by the Central Government. The petitioner does not even specify as to under which enactment the cess is levied. In any event, as per the very averment of the petitioner, the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) of India has issued recommendations and is following it up.

2. We are of the opinion that the Public Interest Litigation is unnecessary. In the above circumstances, the petitioner, an Advocate of this Court appearing in person



submitted that she will withdraw the case.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
