2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 494, 323, 380 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Petitioner is said to have tortured the victim.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that after lodging this case, the complainant had also solemnized another marriage with one Upendra Yadav but unfortunately, she died due to sudden illness on 11.02.2024. He further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.



6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Complaint Case No. 577C of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
