2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323, 452, 324, 325, 307, 379, 504, 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Petitioner along with other accused persons are said to have assaulted the informant by pelting bricks and stone and iron rod.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that though there is specific allegation against the petitioner but injury found upon the victim is simple in nature. He submits that both sides are neighbour and there is some dispute between the parties due to drainage water. He



further submits that petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that the injury found upon the victim is simple in nature, let the above named petitioner in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Sonepur P.S. Case No. 457 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.
