(ii) For further order, direction or writ for quashing the order dated 23.12.2016 (Annexure-10) passed by the Public Grievance Settlement Officer, Phulparas, District Madhubani."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances.
