APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 25(1-B)a, 26 and 35 of
the Arms Act.

3. As per prosecution case, at the instance of the
petitioner, there has been recovery of one loaded country-made
pistol and two live cartridges from the house of one Nunu
Thakur and 10 live cartridges from co-accused Munnu Thakur.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. The petitioner has no concern with the
alleged arms and cartridges, which were seized by the police.



Only on the basis of suspicion and due to his criminal antecedents, petitioner has implicated in the present case by the police. No incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has remanded in this case on 13.10.2023 and since then he is languishing in judicial custody.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-Ist, Samastipur in connection with Tajpur P.S. Case No. 514 of 2023.
