2      29-04-2024                      1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the  
following relief(s):-

*“1. That this writ application is being filed for writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions commanding respondents No.1, 2 & 3 to initiate proceedings against the respondent No.4 & 5 as they have illegally demolished the ancestral house of the petitioner situated on Khata No.58, Khesra No.407 & 408, Area-07 decimals at the Village- Basauli Narayan, P.S. Bochahan, District- Muzaffarpur. This application is further being filed for a direction to the respondent authorities to reconstruct the house of the*



*petitioner and make a payment of the appropriate compensation to himself (Petitioner). ”*
