2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 290 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-b)a, 26 and 35 of Arms Act.

3. Prosecution case relates to recovery of one country made pistol from the possession of this petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. He has no concern with the seized incriminating weapon. A statement has been made in para-3 of this petition that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. Moreover, he is languishing in judicial custody since



27.06.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6.Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody of the petitioner, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail **after framing of charge if the charge is not framed** in connection with Tajpur (Halai O.P.) P.S. Case No. 367 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-I, Samastipur.
