APP for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He submits that there is no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner rather 2488.320 liters foreign liquor is said to have recovered from the truck. He further submits that petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail application on which he is on bail.

4. Petitioner is agreed to deposit a sum of Rs. 1,00000 (Rupees one lakh) in the account of Mahavir Cancer



Sansthan Bearing Account No. 3332964762, Central Bank of India, Chitkohra Branch, IFSC Code CBIN0282779 (fifth character is zero) MICR Code- 800016018.

5. Considering the facts and circumstance of the case and submissions of the parties, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/successor court in connection with Tajpur P.S. Case No. 570 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C., with further conditions:

(i) One of the bailors will be his own blood relative, preferably, father, mother, brother, sister and/or his wife.

(ii) The petitioner shall not indulge himself in any similar offence till conclusion of the trial.

6. The bail bond of the petitioner shall be accepted by the learned Court below on showing receipt of the aforesaid amount in the account of Mahavir Cancer Sansthan.
