ORAL ORDER

2 13-02-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case in connection with Jamo Bazar P.S. Case No. 34 of 2023 dated 02.03.2023 registered for the offence/s punishable u/s 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, three unknown miscreants are alleged to have stopped the informant's motorcycle and started assaulting and pushed the informant and his companion from the motorcycle and fired two rounds near the leg of the informant and looted 4,25,000/- from them and fled away.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused Akshay Kumar Sah. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has four other criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court concerned, Siwan in connection with Jamo Bazar P.S. Case No. 34 of 2023, subject to conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

7. The application stands allowed.
