A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 118(1), 324(4) of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner is said to have assaulted the informant by means of bricks.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that no person has sustained injury in the alleged occurrence. Petitioner has five criminal antecedents as mentioned in para-3 of this application.



5. Learned APP for the State opposes prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that no person has sustained injury in the alleged occurrence, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Bahadurpur P.S. Case No. 304 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482 (2) of the B.N.S.S.
