2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Jadiya P.S. Case No.130/2023 dated 20.05.2023 registered for the offence punishable under Section 23 P.C. & PNDT Act, 1994, pending in the Court of learned A.C.J.M.-II, Supaul.
3. The learned APP at the outset submits that the offence for which the instant F.I.R. has been instituted against the petitioner carries a punishment of less than 7 years to which the learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute.
4. In view of the submission made by the learned APP the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar).

No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar) and the Superintendent of Police shall ensure that Investigating Officer of the case strictly adhere to the direction contained in the order dated 13.02.2024 in Cr. Misc. No.3536/2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. State of Bihar).
