APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 365, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the informant alleged that the petitioner along with co-accused persons abducted his wife and two sons with wrong intention.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence. He has falsely been implicated in this case. The victim was recovered whose statement has been recorded u/s 161 & 164 of the Cr.P.C. There is huge contradiction between the both statement of the victim. According to statement of 161 of Cr.P.C, she has neither



named the petitioner as an accused nor said anything about any wrongdoing. But she further developed the story in her statement u/s 164 of Cr.P.C and stated that the petitioner took her away to Gujrat and committed wrong with her. The victim is major and wedded lady. It is further submitted that the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody since 2.8.2023.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as custody period, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Antichak P.S. Case No. 48 of 2023 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M. 1st Class, Bahgalpur.
