3 30-10-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

*“1) (i) For issuance of an order, direction
and a writ in the nature of Certiorari for
implementation of the order passed by
the Respondent No. 5 dated 19.06.2017,*



under Section 145 Cr.P.C., in Complain Case No. 216/2017, regarding removal of obstruction claimed by Respondents No. 7 to 12 to be a hut, which was put up by respondents No. 7 to 12, over Khata No. 2041, Khesara No. 9498, area 0.08 decimal, situated at village-Sirauli, P.S. Riga, District- Sitamarhi.

(ii) For issuance of an order/direction, commanding the respondent authorities to implement the order passed by Respondent No. 5, which could not be implemented despite one day's salary of Circle Officer i.e. Rs. 1737/- being deposited in lieu of deputation of a Magistrate."

2. Considering the nature of relief sought for in the present writ petition, I deem it fit and proper to grant liberty to the petitioners to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of their aforesaid grievances.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
