ORAL ORDER

2 21-02-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Gaya
Rail P.S. Case No. 390 of 2022 instituted for the offence under
Sections 25(1-B)a, 26 & 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per prosecution case, on secret information
police raided outside the railway platform where five accused
persons seeing the police tried to fled away, but two were
apprehended. On search, one loaded country made pistol was
recovered from the possession of the apprehended persons.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 11-12-2022. Petitioner
bears five criminal antecedents, as per disclosure made in



paragraph No. 3 of the bail application.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. Name of the petitioner has surfaced in this case due to confessional statement of co-accused, namely, Mittua Prasad and Amit Raj, and the same has no evidentiary value. Nothing has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner. Charge sheet has already been submitted in this case.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner and charge sheet being submitted, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Gaya Rail P.S. Case No. 390 of 2022.
