ORAL ORDER

2 29-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. That, this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ (s) / direction (s) for quashing the order dated 02.08.2022 passed by the respondent no.4 in Anganbari Appeal Case No.05 of 2021 by which he was allowed the Anganbari Appeal Case No.05 of 2021 filed by the respondent no.8 and set aside the order dated 02.07.2021 passed by the



respondent no.5 in Anganbari Case No. 135 of 2018, by which the respondent no.5 has allowed the appeal filed by the petitioner and cancelled the selection of the respondent no.8 from the post of Anganbari Sevika of Ward no.1 Gram Panchayat Raj Sarupayee, village-Koreya, Block-Vijayeepur, District-Gopalganj and also directed the respondent no.6 to take action for fresh selection after correction of the mapping register.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, including that of filing a civil suit before the learned civil court of competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
