learned A.P.P. on behalf of the State.

The instant application for regular bail has been

filed by the petitioner in connection with Rajauli P.S. Case

No. 499 of 2022 instituted for the offence punishable under

Sections 341, 323, 366(A), 376, 504, 506/34 of the Indian

Penal Code and Section 4/6 of POCSO Act.

Earlier the application for regular bail of the

petitioner was rejected by order dated 22.05.2023 passed in

Cr. Misc. No. 72708 of 2022 with an observation to learned

trial court to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the

earliest.



In pursuance to the direction of this Court, a report, dated 31.01.2024, with regard to present stage of trial has been received and the same is kept at flag 'A'. From its perusal it appears that the trial may be concluded within a period of six months.

No fresh ground is made for reconsideration of the regular bail of the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for grant of regular bail is rejected.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed off.

However, learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within 4 months., failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer of bail.
