APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468, 471
of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, the accused person namely
Vinod Kumar was caught along with Rs. 3,00,000/- who was
involved in *Hawala* transaction and the police has stated that the
petitioner was also involved in the same.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. He has
committed no offence. Petitioner has no concern with the
alleged occurrence. The name of the petitioner has come into
light, on the basis of confessional statement of co-accused



Vinod Kumar, which has got no evidentiary value in the eyes of law. He submitted that no money has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. He further submitted that the others co-accused have already been granted bail by this Bench vide order dated 06.12.2023 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 78413 of 2023. Petitioner has got no criminal antecedent as stated in para-3 of the bail petition. He is languishing in judicial custody since 12.08.2023.

5. The application for bail is opposed by learned APP for the State.

6. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the facts and circumstances of the case as well as period of custody, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gopalganj in connection with Cyber P.S. Case No. 12 of 2023.
