ORAL ORDER

2 30-01-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Andhramath P.S. case No. 120 of 2023 corresponding to G.R.
No. 1436 of 2023 instituted for the offences under Sections 413,
414 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case, in short, is that police stopped the
accused persons boarded on a motorcycle (without registration
number) during patrolling duty. On search, one mobile phone,
one dagger, one scissors and three keys of various vehicles were
recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
the petitioner is in custody since 07.08.2023 and has one



criminal antecedent. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner was a pillion rider and, in fact, was unaware of the fact that the said motorcycle was a stolen one. The petitioner has got no concern with the said motorcycle. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case merely on suspicion. Learned counsel also submitted that no specific overt act is alleged against the petitioner.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Andhramath P.S. case No. 120 of 2023, corresponding to G.R. No. 1436 of 2023.
