2 29-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following reliefs:-

*"(I) For direction be issued to the
respondent no.06 the Deputy
Development Commissioner cum
the chief Executive Officer Zila
Parishad Patna to make payment of
group Insurance Scheme Arrear of
salary since 01.04.2007 to*



*31.12.2020 as per 6th Pay Revision
Arrear of Gratuity and leave in
cashment on the basis of 7th pay
revision, Benefit of 1st, 2nd and 3rd
ACP and salary of strike period since
01.07.2020 to 11.02.2020.*

*ii. For respondents be directed to
pay 1 % interest over the amount
due since date of entitlement till
date of payment."*

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Deputy Development Commissioner-cum-Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. It is needless to state that in case appropriate representation is filed, within a period of two weeks from today, the Deputy Development Commissioner-cum-Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad, Patna shall dispose off the same by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks, thereafter.



4. The writ petition stands disposed off on
the aforesaid terms.
