As agreed by the parties, Mr. Ajay Kumar Sinha, learned Senior Advocate of the Patna High Court, 27, Bihar Bar Council Bhawan is appointed as learned Arbitrator to adjudicate all disputes arising out of the agreement entered into between the parties to the lis.

8. The Arbitral Tribunal shall issue notice to the respondents.
9. The appeal stands disposed of in the above terms.
