2      29-02-2024              The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this application is filed to set aside the order passed in Anganari Revision Case No. 57/2020, by order dated 13-11-23, passed by the learned Commissioner, Koshi Division, Saharsa by way of writ of certiorari or any other appropriate writ or writs and directs the respondents to appoint petitioner as Anganbari Sevika or pass any other order or orders as your lordships may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

2.              After some arguments, the learned counsel for the



petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law including that of filing a suit before the learned Civil Court having competent jurisdiction.
