seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this is a writ application for issuance of writ in nature of writ of Mandamus commanding the respondent no.2 to constitute a committee for holding proper verification of Educational papers submitted by Respondent no.5 since on fake and forged matriculation certificate, he obtained service in Army causing loss of Public money."
