ORAL ORDER

2 04-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

"That this writ application is filed for issuance of an appropriate writ (s), direction (s), particularly in the nature of mandamus directing and commanding the respondents concerned to pay the petitioner the



arrears/differences of salary of 5th pay revision from March, 2003 to 28th March, 2017 on account of grant of benefit of the 5th pay revision (wrongly written/typed 6th pay revision in place of the 5th pay revision in the order dated 29.12.1999) with effect from 01.01.1996 vide Board's Office Order No.1026 dated 29.12.1999 issued vide Memo No. Pra/1592 dated 29.12.1999 under the signature of Chief Executive Officer, Bihar State Khadi and Village Industrial Board, Bihar, Patna (Respondent No.7)."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent no.7, i.e. the Chief Executive Officer, Bihar State Khadi & Industries Board, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. It is needless to state that in case appropriate representation is filed, within a period of two weeks from today, the respondent no.7 shall dispose off the same by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks, thereafter.



4. The writ petition stands disposed off on
the aforesaid terms.
