2. Yesterday, also when the matter was called out, there was none to represent the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel for the State is present.

4. The grievance of the petitioner is confined to the payment of GPF amount along with up-to-date interest.

5. A counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of respondents no. 7 and 8.

6. The learned counsel for the State referring to the



averments made in the counter affidavit, submits that the admissible GPF amount has already been authorized in favour of the petitioner vide three authority letters bearing no. NW/2023/FP/110 dated 13.04.2023 amounting to Rs. 31,56,103/-; NW/2024/FP/41 dated 08.02.2024 amounting to Rs. 9,87,037/- and NW/2024/FP/51 dated 20.02.2024 amounting to Rs. 6,60,415/- along with up-to-date interest. The aforesaid authority letters have been dispatched to the concerned authority for making payment of the authorized amount. The letters have been brought on record as Annexure-R/A (series) to the counter affidavit.

7. In view of the averments made in the counter affidavit, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
