learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection
with Bisfi (Patauna) P.S. Case No. 150 of 2023 for the offences
punishable under Sections 341, 323, 384, 354, 427, 504, 506
and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The learned APP submits that the offence for which
the instant FIR has been instituted, carries punishment of less
than seven years, the said submission of the learned APP is not
disputed by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioners.

4. In view of the submission made by the learned APP, the anticipatory bail application is disposed of in terms of the order dated 13-2-2024 passed in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. the State of Bihar).

The petitioners would be at liberty to file a representation before the concerned Superintendent of Police and the Investigating Officer of the case, within a period of three weeks from today, with a web copy of the order dated 13-2-2024 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. the state of Bihar); and the concerned Superintendent of Police shall ensure that the Investigating Officer of the case strictly adheres to the directions contained in the the order dated 13-2-2024 in Criminal Miscellaneous No. 3536 of 2024 (Naushad Ansari vs. the State of Bihar).
