2 29-01-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Saharsa
Sadar P.S. Case No. 772 of 2023 instituted for the offences
under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 384, 379, 504, 506/34 of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.

3. The allegation against the accused persons including
the petitioner is of assaulting the Informant. The specific
allegation against the petitioner/Ajit Yadav is of assaulting the
Informant by means iron rod at his head due to which he
sustained grievous injury and blood started oozing.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the



present case and the petitioner has committed no offence as alleged in the F.I.R. He further submits that there is delay of four days in instituting the F.I.R. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 09.11.2023. He further submits that the injuries found over the person of the Informant are simple in nature and, hence, Section 307 of the IPC is not attracted.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case as also taking into account the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner, abovenamed, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Saharsa Sadar P.S. case No. 772 of 2023.
