seeking the following reliefs:-

*“1. a) A Mandamus commanding
the respondent authorities to
construct Panchayat Sarkar Bhawan
at Revenue village-Mansapur in
Khata no. 502, Plot no.4837, 4613
measuring about 5 Acres which is*



most suitable Govt. land under Gram Panchayat Raj Mansapur under Laukahi Block as per resolution dated 30.08.2022 of Panchayati Raj Department (Annexure-p/1) for which an amount of Rs.316,61759 (Lakh) has been sanctioned by the Respondent State.

b) A Mandamus restraining the respondents concerned particularly Mukhiya Gram Panchayat Raj Mansapur from mis-utilising the aforesaid sanction funds in constructing Panchayat Sarkar Bhawan for the benefits his domineering supporters in violating guideline issued by Respondent State where there is no accesses of the members of S.C.,S.T. or weaker sections of the Gram Panchayat Mansapur under Laukahi Block in the District of Madhubani."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the District Magistrate, Madhubani for redressal of their aforesaid



grievances. Liberty so sought is granted.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off.
