2. The present writ petition has been preferred for the grant of following relief/s:-

“That the petitioner craves indulgence of this Hon'ble Court for issuance of appropriate Mandamus or order/orders, command/commands writ in any the other nature an of writ/writs, direction/directions, for directing the respondents to make suitable award for the land of the petitioner which has been demarcated without notice appertaining to

3. Paragraph-7 of the counter-affidavit of the
respondent Nos. 2, 3, 6 and 9 to 11 read as follows:-

*“7. That it is humbly stated and submitted
that the petitioner has no title of the aforesaid
land. The aforesaid land had been acquired by
the Government from the original Raiyat/
Landlord (then) Sri Methur Choudhary, vide
Case No. 27/64-65 under Mahnar- Mohiddin
Nagar- Bachhwara Path Nirmaan Yojna and
Methur Choudhary had been received
compensation of the aforesaid land on
02.09.1971.”*

4. In that background, learned counsel for the
petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the
petition.

5. Permission accorded.

6. The present writ petition stands dismissed as
withdrawn.
